2015 Paix Sur Terre Ugni Blanc Paso Robles (19.99)

The Ugni Blanc at Kiler Grove continues to impress us with its freshness and drinkability year after year. The 2015 has a different twist as we achieved a measly .88 tons per acre, the lowest yield ever at Kiler Grove Vineyard. This natural concentration has given the 2015 a bit more mid palate texture with no shortage of the freshness and minerality typical of this wine.

2006 Beronia Gran Reserva Rioja Spain (39.99)

92 points *Wine Enthusiast*: “*Cellar Selection* Beronia has blended modern and traditional touches to create a fine gran reserva with spice, vanilla, coconut, tobacco and dried berry aromas. The palate offers ripe tannins and kick, while the flavor profile is earthy, with mocha, coffee, chocolate and dried berry flavors. A long, lightly toasted and chocolaty finish provides a fitting end to an excellent wine. Best from 2015–2022.”

2013 Dry Creek Valley Old Vine Zinfandel Sonoma County (34.99)

At first swirl, cardamom and white pepper leap from the glass with spice being a central theme to the wine. Refined and balanced, the wine integrates seamlessly on the palate offering a broad array of blackberry, black cherry, blueberry and toasty oak notes. The wine finishes with elegance and sophistication. This is thoughtful Zinfandel - the kind of wine that requires some good jazz and a fantastic book for a long evening of enjoyment.
