2012 Dunning Meritage, Paso Robles \$32.99

"Crushed blueberries, roasted coffee, vanilla bean, fudge and fragrant lilacs show on the very inviting, floral and jammy nose of this blend of 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc. Red plum and black cherry arise at first sip, followed by a sandalwood-laced boysenberry and cedar character that are framed by tart acidity and a soft tannic structure." *Wine Enthusiast 93*

2013 Robert Craig Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa \$41.99

With the 2013 vintage, we are pleased to present the next generation of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from Robert Craig Winery. Our primary mission is to produce wines that feature pure site expression, and this new Cabernet Sauvignon bottling is no exception. Selected half from our estate vineyards, half from exceptional vineyards around the valley, we present this plush, beautifully structured wine, with the depth and power you expect from a Classic Napa Valley Cabernet. As Affinity moves to a single-vineyard bottling, this wine steps in to take its place in our portfolio. 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 6% Petit Verdot, 6% Malbec, and 4% Cabernet Franc. *Suckling 92*

2013 Incendium Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa \$65.99

Deep, dark, plum/garnet red hue with a medium viscosity. Youthful, powerful cherry and leather, with black currant. Hints of earthiness, cloves, brown sugar and pepper. Off dry, medium acidity with smooth entry. Cherry on the entry building to plum and black currant flavors with fine-tuned tannins in the mid-palate. Finishes with cherry, spices and a hint of white pepper. Fruit forward, beautifully balanced, medium acidity and long finish. *Gold 90 pts. 2010 Chateau Peyraron, Haut Medoc, Cru Bourgeois \$26.99
