2014 Havemeyer Piesporter Michelsberg, Mosel Kabinett Riesling, Germany (19.99)

This aromatic, full-bodied wine offers notes of ripe Fuji apple, raw honey, wet stone, lemon, white flowers and honeysuckle.

The grapes for the 2014 Havemeyer “Kabinett” Riesling were grown in the Piesporter Michelsberg Vineyard, a world-famous vineyard in Germany’s Mosel growing region, encompassing about 3,500 acres of slate soil that stores the heat of the sun during the day so the vines continue to be nourished overnight.

2014 Boomtown by Dusted Valley Merlot Washington (17.99)

Washington state Merlot is phenomenal! The palate is filled with cherries and dusty malted chocolate. Mouth coating tannins make it a great wine for big, flavorful foods. A blend of 88% Merlot, 9% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 3% Petit Verdot.

2013 Langmeil Valley Floor Shiraz Australia (29.99)

On the nose, a rich and dense aroma of Satsuma plum and raspberries mingle with sweet spice, chocolate hints and savoury tones. On the palate, rich, sweet and spicy fruit in balance with velvety yet youthfully austere tannins. A complex, medium to full bodied wine showing hints of mocha and vanilla, which flow through to the lengthy, fruitful, pepper and spice finish.
