2015 Levendi Rosé of Pinot Noir (22.99) Napa Valley

A luminous, soft pink hue caresses the glass with succulent aromas of juicy raspberry and strawberry. The palate is refreshing and expensive with luscious watermelon and Queen Anne cherry nuances. Juicy acidity lingers at the finish with soft strawberry highlights. Yasou Levendi!

2013 L'Ecole #41 Syrah (29.99) Columbia Valley, Washington

Wine Spectator, 92 points: "Firm and chewy around a glowing core of blackberry, blueberry and white pepper flavors, this medium-weight style remains focused and spicy as the finish lingers."

2011 Crocus Malbec de Cahore (\$39.99) France

Wine Spectator, 91 points: "Full-bodied, with fine-grained tannins and a firm, zesty acidity that highlights the raspberry and currant flavors. Fresh herb and floral undertones are accentuated by sweet spice notes that linger on the finish."

From the winemaker: Deep purple, with touches of fuchsia on the rim. An intense Malbec displaying aromas of red cherry, blueberry, rose petal, ripe Italian plum, black licorice and spice box. The palate is concentrated and bright, cascading with focused flavors of black cherry, red plum, milk chocolate, talc and hints of butterscotch and star anise, supported by fine-grained tannins.
